

DMTF Privacy Policy

The Distributed Management Task Force Inc. (DMTF) has long recognized that individuals with whom we conduct business value their privacy. However, in order to provide global DMTF membership benefits in this increasingly electronic world, the collection of personal information is often necessary and desirable. It is the DMTF's goal to balance the benefits of providing information and services via the Internet with the right of its members to prevent the misuse of their personal information.

The Collection of Personal Information

If you supply us with your telephone number on-line you may receive telephone contact from us with information regarding new services, or upcoming events. If you do not wish to receive telephone calls, please tell us.

Collecting Domain Information

The DMTF also collects domain information as part of its analysis of the use of this site. This data enables us to become more familiar with people who visit our site, how often they visit and what parts of the site they visit most often. The DMTF uses this information to improve its web-based offerings. This information is collected automatically and requires no action on your part.

Data Security

The DMTF is committed to taking reasonable steps to protect the individual identifying information that you provide to us.

Use of Cookies

Some pages on this site use "cookies," which are small files that the site places on your hard drive for identification purposes. These files are used for site registration and customization the next time you visit us. You should note that cookies cannot read data off of your hard drive.
